SCHOOL TO PARENT COMMUNICATION:

FMS is committed to maintaining effective communication and providing our student's families with the information they need to keep their students on track and growing. We encourage both students and guardians to keep current with upcoming events and activities by regularly checking our website at <u>forsythpanthers.org</u>. Also, take advantage of opportunities such as the SIS training meeting on September 5th and parent-teacher conferences on October 17th and 18th, to touch base with your student's teachers. In addition, FMS has a common conference plan time for each grade level of teachers. Teachers are available to meet with parents in person or on the phone during this time. Fifth and eighth grade plan time is from 9:14-10:04 Monday-Friday and sixth and seventh grade level plan time is from 8:20-9:10 Monday-Friday. Another way to contact teachers is through email. - Get connected with our online grade book, Tyler SIS 360. This is a great way for you to stay upto-date with attendance, discipline, lunch balance, missing assignments, and your child's academic progress. You can contact the office for login information.

- If your child is missing an assignment, you will receive an automated call from the school on Monday each week. You would then want to look on SIS, visit with your child, and review the Schoology calendar with them.

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL:

District-wide, all students will start the 2019-2020 school year on Thursday, August 15th. Fifth and sixth grade students will go directly to their homeroom class, which is also their first hour class. Students may drop their items off in their homeroom and then go to breakfast. After breakfast, they need to be back in their first hour class prior to the tardy bell that rings at 8:20am. Seventh and eighth grade students will go directly to the middle school gym. Students may drop their items off in the gym and then go to breakfast. After breakfast, they need to return to the middle school gym until the bell rings for first hour. The first few days, teachers will be getting students familiar with this procedure as well as helping students with directions, lockers, bathrooms, getting to lunch, and finding their buses at the end of the day. If you bring or pick up your child, you will drop them off and pick them up in front of the middle school building. First period will begin at 8:20 am; students are not allowed into the building until 7:50 am. School ends at 3:00 pm. Students are expected to ride the bus, walk home, attend Boys and Girls Club or get picked up, unless they have a note from a parent or legal guardian changing their normal routine. If students are going to another student's house, we need a note from the guardian of each student before a bus pass will be issued.
